Do you see the potential for increases in earned income in your future?

Do you anticipate becoming employed, getting a raise, earning a promotion, or going from part-time to full-time employment within the next year?

Would you like help establishing goals and becoming familiar with the services available to help you and your family become self-sufficient?

Is the idea of being awarded a special savings account and freeing your family from public assistance appealing to you?

If your answer to these questions is "YES", contact the Asheboro Housing Authority and ask about the FSS program.

Asheboro Housing Authority is offering a program, in connection with the Section 8 Rental Assistance Program, called Family Self Sufficiency (FSS). FSS works to help families become financially independent from public assistance or welfare by addressing individual problems which have prevented families from obtaining/maintaining employment. Through this program, families set their own goals and work to meet those goals. The Housing Authority partners with these families by helping with case management, making agency referrals, and establishing an escrow account (a special savings account) for the participants. Any money in the account is paid to the family when they meet their contract for use of meeting their end goals and are free of public assistance. Families have up to 5 years from the time they begin the program to complete their goals. Choosing to become involved in this program could be the best decision you ever make.
